

Pastor Jeff is an amazingly gifted teacher of God's word. Jody and I have been attending Ada Bible Church only 2 ½ years, but we've already grown so much under his teaching. Even our kids, aged 12, 15 and 21, are able to track with him each week!

The first time we came to ABC, Jeff used Genesis 1 as his text. The story of creation is, of course, familiar but Jeff showed us something we'd never seen before when he said, "It says here that the earth was dark and empty. Now, if you've ever felt that dark and empty is all you have to bring to God, let's watch and see what He can do with it." And then he read on...but we kept pondering this thought about how God creates spiritual, emotional, and physical life out of nothing.

It wasn't even his main point, yet the idea of surrendering to the Lord whatever we have, even if it's merely "dark and empty," continues to have a big impact on us today.

Another example of the effect of Jeff's teaching on us comes from last year's Satisfied series. In it Jeff unpacked a lot about the culture of Ephesus, specifically as it relates to adoption. Because all three of our children are adopted, this particular doctrine is quite precious to us. However, we knew nothing about the prolific abandonment of children by their fathers in that city, nor the way that those children could be saved from exposure to the elements and death on a hillside—through adoption!

This contextual backdrop gave the Apostle Paul's words so much more meaning, especially when Jeff added that the <u>inheritance</u> of an adopted son in Ephesus was both legally binding and forever secured. Blood-born children could be cut off from their inheritance for any reason by the patriarch, but, Jeff explained, adopted ones were guaranteed a future.

We continue to be comforted by this insight as it relates to our own eternal security through adoption, and are grateful to Jeff for giving it to us.

Jeff also honors his wife, Chris, frequently and publically. He is careful to appropriately reference her in a message, in a particular thank you to the congregation for something, or in the general welcome or specific holiday greeting.



It is clear that they <u>together</u> are pastoring this church and its members. We, too, are a ministry couple and value a public display of their partnership in the gospel.

Thank you, Jeff and Chris, for standing faithfully at the Ada Bible Church post these two and a half decades! It's indeed a privilege to send this note of encouragement your way—congratulations on being highlighted in this Pastor Care newsletter!
