About eight years ago I was diagnosed with a terminal illness called Huntington's disease. It is a terrible neurological disease that produces extreme involuntary movements and dementia. There is no medical treatment or cure. My doctor told me within 2-5 years, my symptoms would be significant (most people live 10-20 years after diagnosis). During a healing service, Pastor Duane placed hands on me and said, "Be healed in Jesus name". I have not had a symptom since. My doctor is astounded because I should be in very bad shape right now. Thank you Jesus!

Pastor Duane is also awesome because he preaches the Word of God and does not bow down to societal pressure to omit what is not popular. One of my favorite things he says is (while holding up a Bible), "Who believes what Isaiah 6:3 says?" A few people raise their hand. He continues, "What does it say? I have no idea but if it is in the Word of God it has to be true". Whenever a sermon speaks to my heart, I buy it and listen to it in the car on my way to work each day (I now have enough where they repeat every six months or so). It is amazing to me how many times I've been through some trial at work or at home and it was as though God selected that sermon just for me. This happens weekly (it happened today)!



Resurrection Life Church has a television ministry called "Walking By Faith" that airs Pastor Duane's sermons. The program reaches millions of people and countless numbers have been saved through it. Both my wife and I support this ministry. We see it as our opportunity to promote the "great commission".

Pastor Duane and Jennie are both awesome leaders and Res Life has grown through their tireless love for the church. They have great youth programs, support missions, a food pantry, stand with Israel and many other wonderful ways to spread the gospel.
